Develop a Funding Strategy

- Cllrs must understand finances as a start-point
- Setting the Precept
- PWLB
- Income
- Asset Replacement
- Medium to long-term financial planning

Three Main Strands of Funding

Big Lottery Fund

Landfill Funders

Trusts

Understanding Potential Funders

- Choose the Right Funder
- Getting to know them
- Understand the question
- Gathering evidence
- Explaining your solution

Identifying and Demonstrating Need

- Consult and engage
- Involve User Group(s)
- Desk research

Making Sense of Outcomes

"Outcomes are the changes that will come about as a result of the project"

Examples

- Reduction in anti-social behaviour
- More young people engaged in positive activities
- Improved family relationships
- More positive community attitude to young adults

What Does a Good Application Look Like – Top Tips?

- Get informed, find out what local support is available
- Don't start your project until you've successfully applied!
- Need funder's objectives match your proposals?
- Talk to body before applying

Top Tips continued

- Project/business plan
- Imagination and lateral thinking required
- Match funding
- Demonstrate that your project cannot proceed without support
- Get it checked over be critical
- Would you give your money to this request?
