I have been a member of Yate Town Council since 1983 and held many position as Chair of Cmtte and Town Mayor. I have also been a member of South Gloucestershire Council and it's predecessors councils since 1983.

I have been a member of the Avon Calc during most of that time - NALC rep since 2011 - member of the Management Board since December 2017, Member of Larger Councils' Cmtte since May 2015 directed elected 2015 & 2917.

Yate Town Council is largest member Council in Avon with Budget of £1.3M. We have taken over Youth Services within the Town; we run all play areas and tow larger Parks which we run with support from User Groups. Kingsgate Park has won regional awards from Britain in Bloom and

During my time on the Yate TC we have grown from having a Part Time Clerk based in a Portacabin to having a staff of 30 providing Sports, Parks, Play and Youth Work. We bought an about to be demolished Victoria's Mansion and turned it into a Town Hall and Council Chamber providing a Wedding Venue and offices for Community Groups

I believe that NALC is important to represent the Town/Parish Council sector to Government and the public. Larger Councils can demonstrate what is possible with local and democratically accountable bodies.

## ©villnethice/key addievements that are relevent to the work of the targer councils committee

Armadillo Youth Cafe and Venue, a £1.5 M facility which is open 7 days per week - all year round. Developed in partnership with South Gloucestershire Council. Now solely owned and operated by Yate TC after SG Council stopped its financial contribution.

Yate Outdoor Sports Complex. Started by Yate TC and expanded with support first by Northavon District Council and then with Avon CC (both merged into South Gloucestershire Council). For a while run (down) by SG Council - the Town Council has taken on full responsibility for YOSC and has now put a new all weather track in place and has completely relaid an all! weather hockey/ football pitch.

Kingsgate Park, originally South Gloucestershire run, the Town Council has taken it over in exchange for reduction of Special Expenses Council Tax for the Town. Working with a Friends Group the Council has provided a very large Adventure Play Area; up graded other play equipment. An Outdoor Gym is being installed. The TC provides Annual music festival (Yate Rocks) with local bands and dance groups; Easter Egg hunt and other events.
