You should have an interest in contributing to shaping written submissions and responses and be willing to promote the objectives of the sector and not as your own local council or county association. Access to websites, emails and the ability to comment electronically on Microsoft Word would be advantageous. As well as attending meetings, committee members should contribute to the public affairs work of NALC. The overall commitment is around 20 days per year. The Policy Committee also acts as the government sponsored; Sustainable Communities Act Board, which can recommend government considers changes in legislation or processes identified by councils. Expenses will be covered.
