I have served on my Parish Council for about 5 years since 2012. I was twice co-opted and also took up a seat in an uncontested election on a council with 13 seats. Since being on the Council, I have helped to maintain benches, bus shelters, the village pound and the de-fibrilator. I have carried out traffic and asset surveys, delivered information leaflets and played an important role in the setting up and maintenance of the Parish Council website.

I have regularly followed the activity of other Parish Councils, and at times the District and County Councils, including attending meetings and consultation events. I have also attended PCC, Police, Emergency planning exercises, SALC meetings and training courses on being a councillor, and how community buildings are set up. I have also taken an interest in the proposed development at Sizewell Nuclear Power Station.

My working life has been with various Police departments in Norfolk and Suffolk Police including management services, and an exchange scheme with Chicago Police Department. It also included training probationer officers and PCSO's, and working with Town and Parish Councils as part of a Safer Neighbourhood Team to address local issues. I was a Custody Officer, and Emergency Response Officer, trained in First Aid, use of De-fibrilator, some form design, and research on a number of police related projects.
