

## **Campaign Progress**

- Community Governance Review undertaken:
  - <u>South Willesborough and Newtown</u> petition submitted –
    26.3% turnout 54.6% YES 45.4% NO
  - <u>North Willesborough</u> valid petition submitted 33.1% turnout 44.2% Yes 55.8% NO
  - <u>Kennington</u> valid petition submitted 34.9% turnout 53.3%
    YES 46.7% NO
  - Central Ashford 28.6% turnout 39% YES 61% NO
  - <u>South Ashford</u> 26.1% turnout 37.8% YES 62.2% NO
- Verification of Petition Signatures
  - Rochester
    - submitted petition on 7 October 2015 (92%)
    - Re-submitted petition on 12 May 2016



## **Ashford Campaign Outcome**

- 2 new Community Councils from 2019:
  - South Willesborough and Newtown
  - Kennington
- KALC continuing to engage with the 3 other campaign areas

- Tackling the additional tier of Local Government and additional costs issues public perception
- Leaflet delivery
- Local Politics
- Online petitions
- Maintaining momentum from petition to CGR consultation
- Sharing the load amongst the campaign group
- Use of social media

- Street Canvassing high street, outside Doctor's Surgery, Local Primary School
