Projects - Identify What You Need

- What complaints and concerns have you received?

- Is this a job for you, or partner or?
- Is everyone agreed and clear on direction?
- Is it really needed and can you explain it?

Build an Evidence Base

- Central and Local government Statistics
- Appropriate consultation you have to do this!
- Think about the issues -
- Maybe, Health and well-being, anti-social behaviour, intergenerational, community cohesion, regeneration

Prepare a Solution Bid

Be clear about target groups and beneficiaries

- Focus on Outcomes
- Partnership good!
- Think Sustainability
- Think Evaluation

Finding your Funding!

- Each funder has their own aims, criteria and funding conditions
- Speak to them if you can
- Choose carefully
- Think Big Lottery Fund, Landfill, Trusts and funds, Central and local authorities, Sponsorship, Crowdfunding

Apply!

- Avoid assumptions, tell a story
- Need and Outcomes
- Innovation
- Publicise success if you are lucky
- Evaluation
