CYBERCRIME

- Fraud & Cybercrime are the UKs most common Offences
- Cybercrime now accounts for over half of Reported Crime
- Rarely a week goes by without a Data breach or Cybercrime story hitting the headlines
- Everyone could be a victim
- Local councils hold significant volumes of personal and sensitive data





WHAT ARE THE SIGNIFICANT RISKS TO LOCAL COUNCILS

- Ransomware = Lost Data / Additional costs ie Forensics
- Phishing = Money Loss / Lost Data
- CEO Fraud = Money Loss
- Human Error = Data protection / money loss
- Denial of Service attacks = Additional costs ie Forensics
- Telephone Hacking = Money Loss
- GDPR = Prospect of Increased Fines / Additional costs







CHANGE IS COMING. GDPR

- Mandatory Notification The ICO must be notified of any data breach with 72 hours of the breach being discovered
- Fines of up to 4% of worldwide turnover or EUR 20,000,000, whichever is higher.
- More Rights For Data Subjects
- Compensation for `Non Material` damage` has been added ie. Distress Claims

Educate staff and refresh training regularly	Make sure Data is regularly backed up	Have up to Data security policies in place
Vet your Outsource Service Providers	Physical Network Controls/Malware protection	Monitoring & Double Verification Procedures
